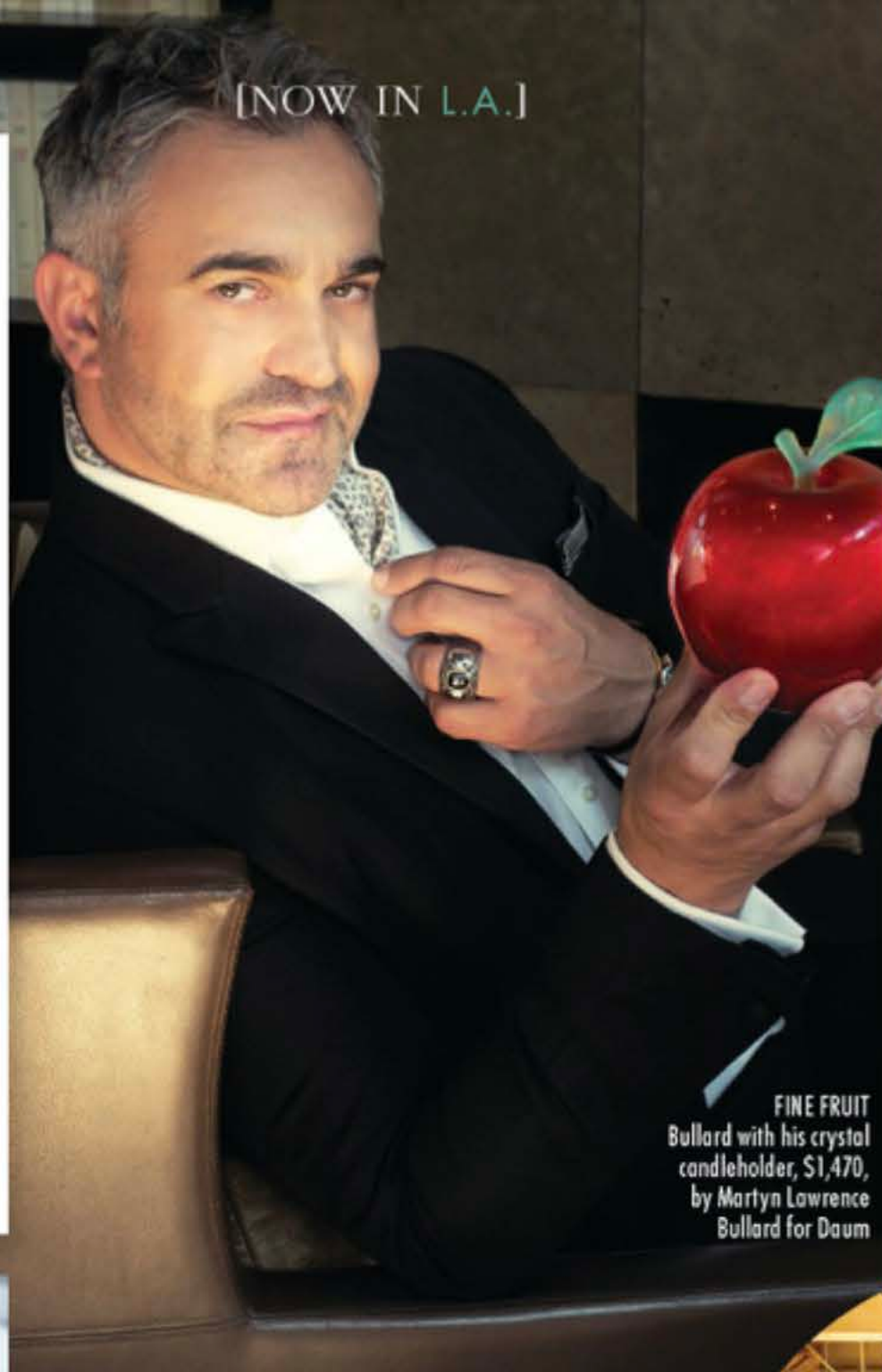

Martyn Lawrence Bullard has gone biblical. The British interior designer has teamed up with French crystal-maker Daum to create a luxurious apple-shaped paperweight (\$675), candleholder (\$1,470) and leafy chandelier (price upon request), all inspired by the Garden of Eden and sold at Gearys Beverly Hills (gearys.com). "It is a very fun, sexy collection. It lets the quality of the crystal literally shine through," says Bullard, who has relished the collaboration and plans to keep it coming. "I would love to do beautiful tableware and glassware," he hints about the future of his line. Between romps at Daum's factory in France, Bullard can be found around L.A., which has been his home for 24 years.
